What is the aim of **Me** first?

Me first focuses on putting children and young people (CYP) in the **centre** of conversations and involving them in choices and decisions about their care

Why **Me** first?



57% CYP said they were not fully involved in choices or decisions about their care



32% CYP said they did not always understand what staff said when they spoke to them

(Care Quality Commission (2017) – 2016 CYP inpatient and day case survey)



How does **Me** first combat this?

Me first is a educational programme that helps health and care workers to develop their knowledge, skills and confidence in communicating with children



How does **Me** first work?

We have worked in partnership with children, young people and health and care professionals to develop a range of educational resources:

- Top tips from health and care professionals and young people


Training impact


